
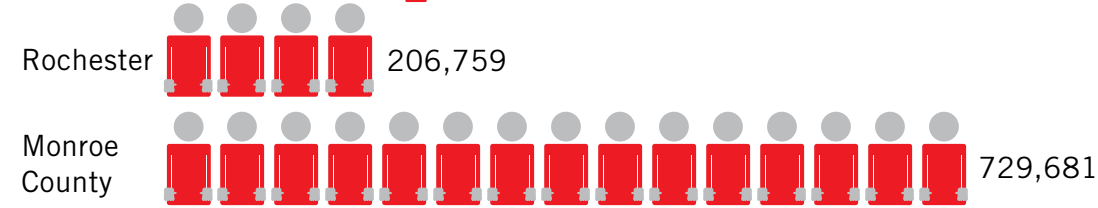

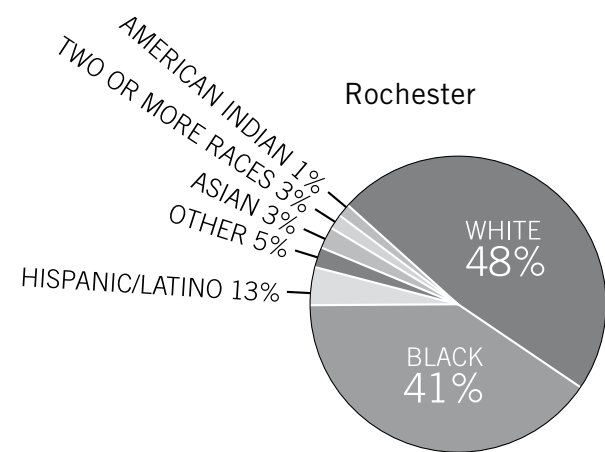

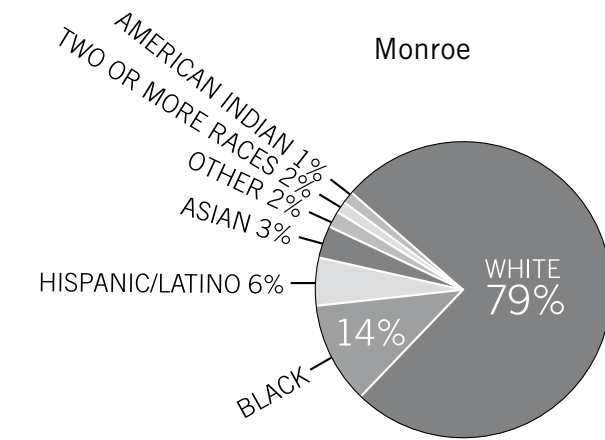
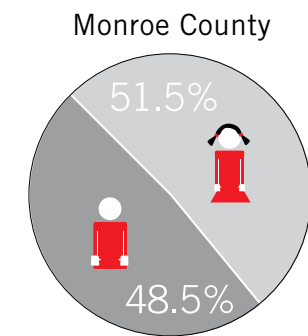
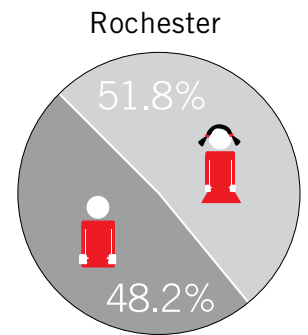
MEDIAN RESIDENT AGE

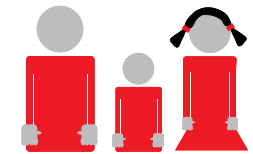
RACIAL BREAKDOWN



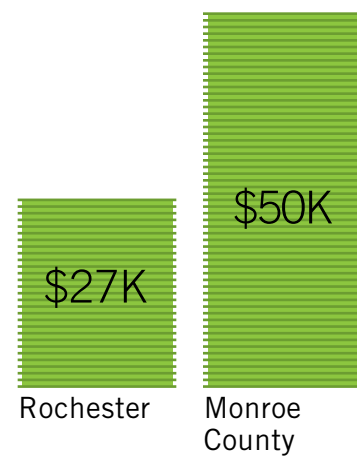
GENDER BREAKDOWN



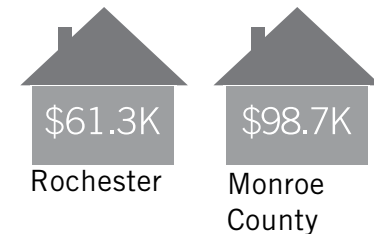
AVERAGE FAMILY SIZE



MEDIAN FAMILY INCOME

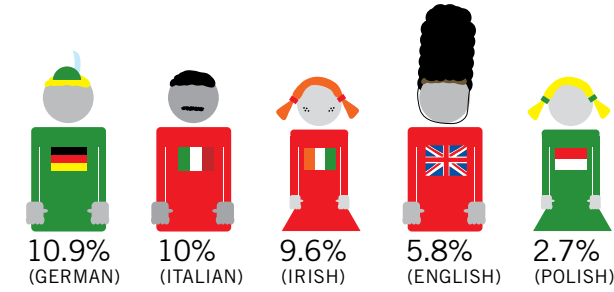


MEDIAN HOUSE PRICE

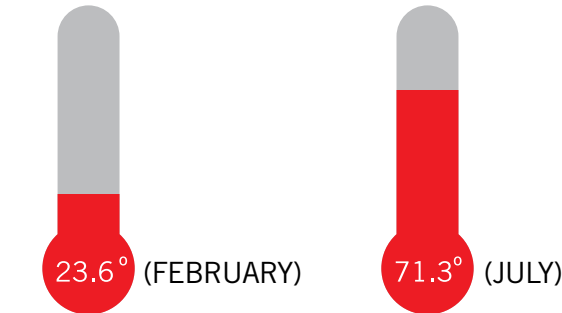


MEAN TRAVEL TIME TO WORK

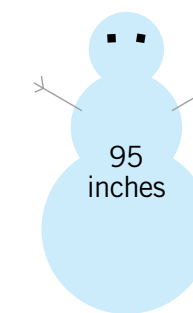
